DEAREST PRINCESS broke sharply, pressed the pace from the outside, rallied, gained the lead in the late stretch and won driving. SUPER STARLETT broke sharply, assumed command, set the pace, gave way. AQUATIC CAT broke sharply, allowed to settle on the inside, rallied from three wide and finished well. THERUSSIANROCKET away alertly and well placed, tracked the leaders from the inside, was outfinished in the stretch. INDY BEAUTY trailed for the first half mile, showed little and failed to menace. ESCUINAPA away alertly and well placed, tracked the leaders from off the rail, was through after the half. SEAFAIR slow early, showed little and was not a factor.
